



Office Cognitive Test (Neurotrax)

An **Office Cognitive Test (Neurotrax)** is a computerized test in the office which measures a patient's cognition on several different panels to better assess memory loss, cognitive decline, or dementias. This test can be done to measure a patient's initial base of cognition or complaints of memory loss and can be done every 6 months to reassess improvement or decline in cognition or memory loss.

- This test is administered on a computer at our clinic and will be assisted by a Medical Assistant throughout the entire test.
- This test will last approximately one hour.
- There is no "prep" for this study.
- Once the test is complete, the results will be given at a follow up appointment.
